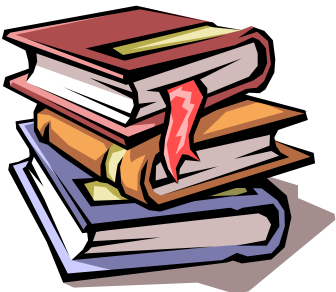

PAY-FOR-PRINT INSTITUTED!



Due to increasing print costs and soaring waste, all University Libraries have instituted a pay-for-print system. This system will require all computer users to pay two cents per black and white page, and 25 cents for each color page. In order to print, you will have to use your red RebelCOPY card (these cards are also used in all campus photocopies as well). Printing instructions are located at the first and second floor Print Stations. Please contact a Staff Member if you need help.

If you don't have a card, you can purchase one at the ASL Service Desk or the RebelCOPY card dispenser across from the copy machine. There is an initial charge of \$1 for each card. **This does NOT include any value for printing.**



NEW BOOKS

Over the summer, the ASL has purchased **MANY** new books, which are displayed on top of the Reference Stacks near the ASL Service Desk. These books are available for you to browse and/or checkout.

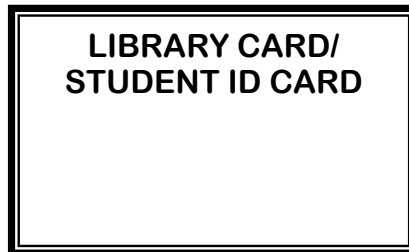


NEW COMPUTERS

New computers have been installed at the ASL over the summer. All terminals include Internet access, with direct links to the ASL's website and Online Catalog. The workstations in the ASL's Computer Lab (second floor, room 203) are also equipped with Microsoft Office 2000. **REMINDER: Drinks are not allowed at any computer workstation or in the Computer Lab!**

USER AUTHENTICATION

As many of you may have noticed, you are required to authenticate, or identify yourself, to the computers before you may use them. This is a campus-wide requirement and is not specific to the ASL. The simple software requires you to input your first name, last name, and barcode number from your **updated** library card (this may be on your UNLV Student ID card, your blue Nevada Library card, or the new red and white University Libraries card). All barcodes are 14 digits long, and look similar to the one below. **DON'T FORGET TO LOGOUT WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED USING THE TERMINAL.**
