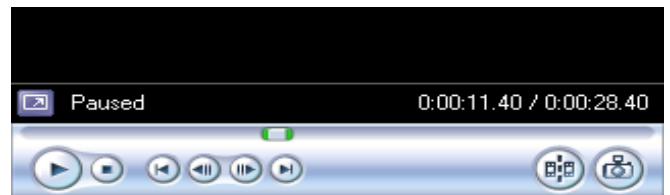
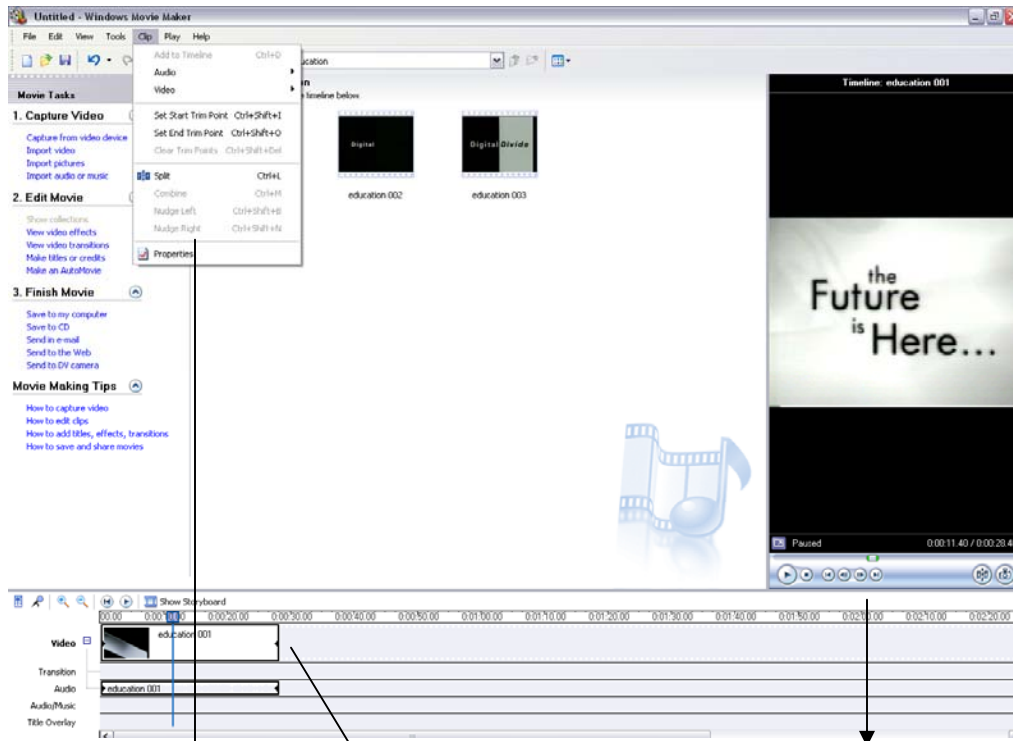

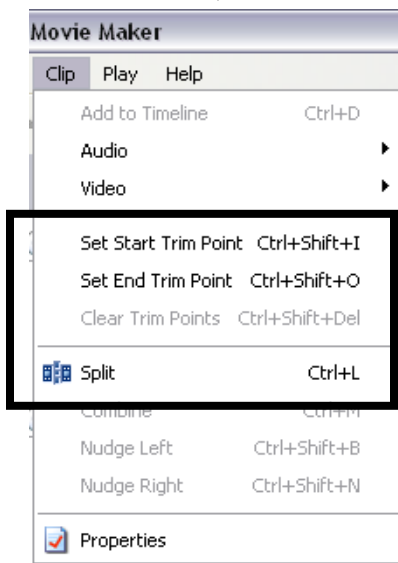

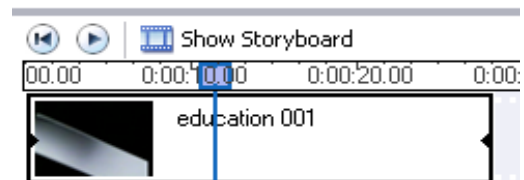
EDITING

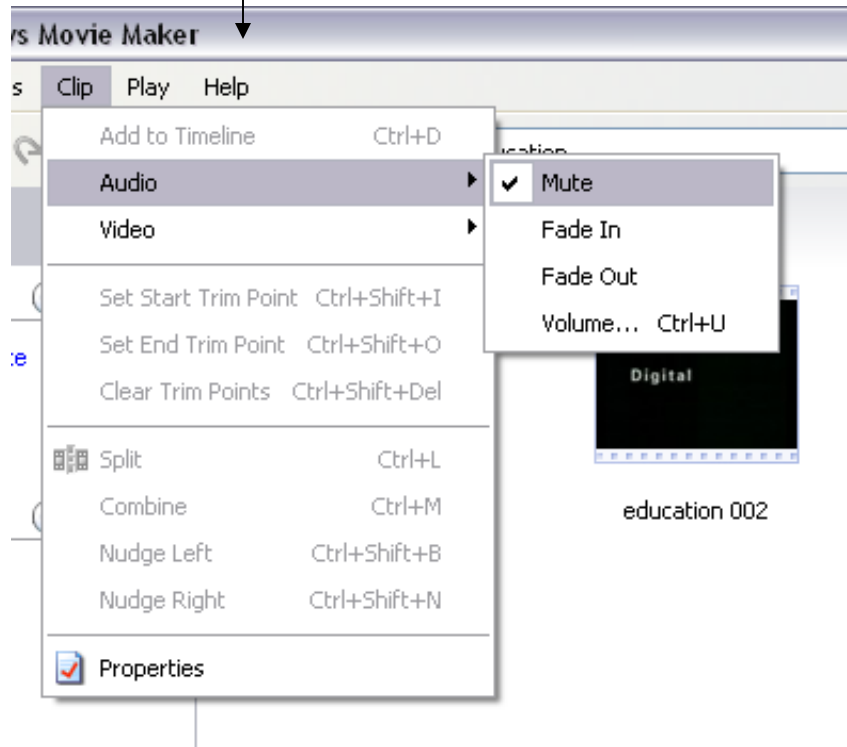
Where do you want to add a title?

- Add [credits at the end](#) of the movie.

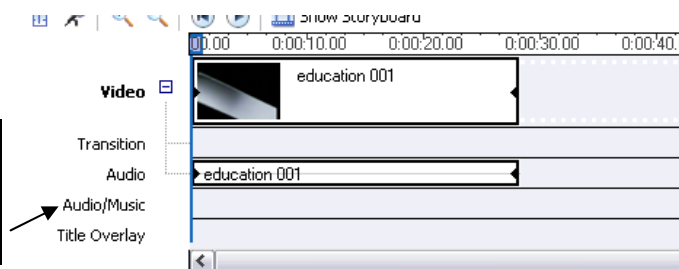

To mute the audio of a video clip highlight the clip (section) in the timeline and...



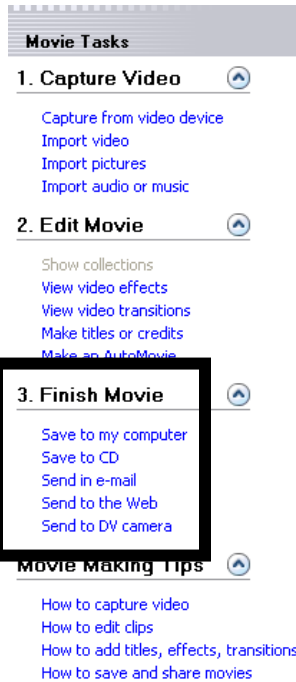
To add your own audio import it and drag it onto the audio music timeline.



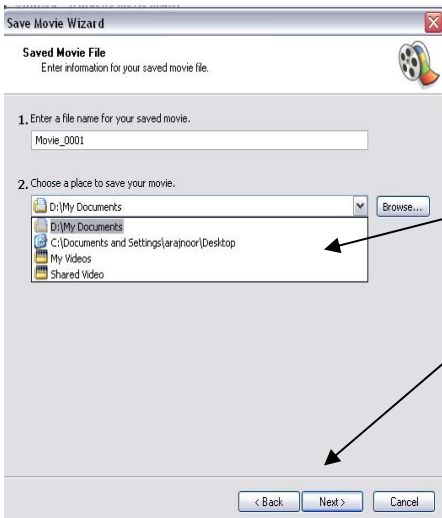
To take stills from video click the camera at the bottom of the preview screen.



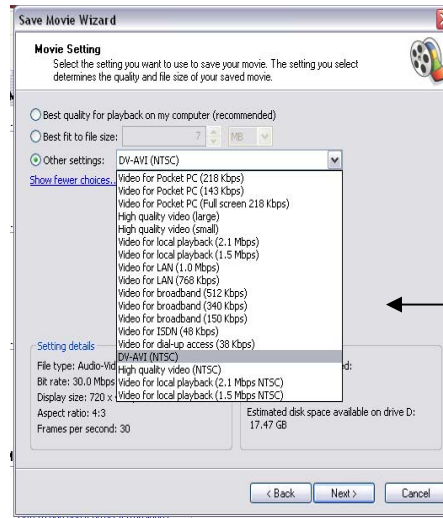
FINISHING THE MOVIE
